Summary of the Comprehensive School Safety Plan (CSSP)

In compliance with California Education Code, the Point Dume Marine Science School staff and parents have reviewed and assessed safety at our school. Assessment indicates Point Dume Marine Science School is a safe school, and we are determined to continue with programs that support safety for the children and staff of our school community. Our Action Plan focuses the maintenance of these safety programs.

Our Comprehensive School Safety Plan includes the following state mandates:

- Child abuse reporting procedures
- Disaster procedures for earthquake, fire, flood, bomb threat, civil disobedience, and intruders on campus
- Policies related to suspension or expulsion
- School wide dress code
- Procedures for student arrival at and dismissal from school
- A safe and orderly environment that is conducive to learning
- School rules
- Procedures for reporting hate crimes
- Sexual harassment policy
- Procedures for notifying teachers of dangerous students.

Point Dume Marine Science School is committed to a safe learning environment for all students. Staff at Point Dume regularly participates in trainings designed to help students better manage their own behavior, mediate conflicts and to develop social problem solving skills. Teachers incorporate the “Six Pillars of Character” across the curriculum emphasizing the common vocabulary of respect, responsibility, caring, fairness citizenship and trustworthiness. The “Great Expectations” program further assists students in the development of problem-solving skills that enable them to reflect on decision-making, self-advocacy and foster skills that encourage and support their personal resiliency. We have added the Cool Tools Program as well as the Safe School Ambassadors program in an effort to support our students’ resiliency skills.
